

Photography and Video Camera Guidelines

THURSTONLAND CRICKET CLUB

- ✓ The club will ask for parental permission via the Player Profile Form to use their child's image and wherever possible show the image to the parents and child in advance. This ensures that they are aware of the way the image will be used to represent the cricket club.
 - ✓ The club will ask for the child's permission via the Player Profile Form to use their image. This ensures that they are aware of the way the image will be used to represent the cricket club.
 - ✓ If the cricketer is named, the club will avoid using their photograph.
 - ✓ If a photograph is used, the club will avoid naming the child.
 - ✓ The club will only use images of children in appropriate kit (training or competition), to reduce the risk of inappropriate use, and to provide positive images of the children.
 - ✓ The primary use of photographs will be to promote the club via our website at www.thurstonlandcc.com if any parent or child would like an image removing they should ask the Child Welfare Officer who will ensure this is removed at the first opportunity.
 - ✓ The club also encourages the use of video as a coaching tool especially with older children. The club will ask for permission from the parents / carers and the child via the Player Profile Form prior to any video being taken.
 - ✓ The club encourages the reporting of any suspected inappropriate use of images or video of children. If you or your child have any concerns please report them to the Club or County Welfare Officer. Any incidents will be recorded in the same manner as any other child protection concern.
